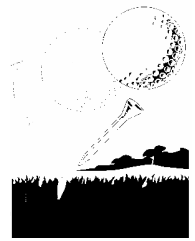


18th Annual Fall Golf-A-Thon Fundraiser

EVENT — 18th Annual Fall Golf-A-Thon Fundraiser...a golf event like no other! A fabulous day of golf with the entire course reserved for the whole day. **Frank Tanana from the Detroit Tigers** will be sharing highlights from his life story with us during lunch.

PURPOSE — To raise significant ministry funds for the work of The Navigators in the Lansing, Ann Arbor and Metro Detroit areas.

DATE — Monday, September 21st, 2009. We have reserved the entire course just for us from 7:00 am until 7:00 pm. We'll have coffee ready at 7:00 am.

WHO CAN PLAY — We are looking for two types of golfers:

1. GOLF-A-THON (all day) GOLFERS — Recruit others to sponsor you to play in the event

- Each Golf-A-Thon (all day) golfer is asked to raise a minimum of \$1000.00 from sponsors before the event, or give a donation yourself, plus send 25 letters to others asking them to give a tax-deductible gift along with you (a printable letter is on our website).
- You can play golf at the event all day from 7:30 am until 6:30 pm if you'd like, or come for a round or two in the morning or afternoon if your schedule is tight. We'll use a quick play format – twosomes only, individual carts for each golfer, no practice swings, pick-up ball within putter's length of pin, don't wait for your partner to hit, leave lost balls.
- Meet at course at 7:00 am – Start golfing at 7:30 am (rain or shine).
Play until 6:30 pm – Dinner OYO on the way home.
- Several fun contests with prizes – longest drive, closest to the pin, etc.
- Lunch buffet at 1:00 pm with **Frank Tanana of the Detroit Tigers** sharing highlights from his life story while we eat.
- Special prizes for those who raise more than \$1200.00 from sponsors.

2. SCRAMBLE GOLFERS — Four-Golfer 18 Hole Scramble—Choose between morning or afternoon

Morning scramble 8:30 am—1:00 pm (driving range open at 7:30 am) - Lunch buffet 1:00 pm—2:00 pm

Afternoon scramble 2:15 pm—6:45 pm (driving range open at 12:00 noon) - Lunch buffet 1:00 pm—2:00 pm

- We would like to have 36 golfers in the morning scramble, and 36 golfers in the afternoon scramble, so recruit three golfers to join you, or we'll place you in a foursome.
- Morning scramble golfers arrive by 8:00 am (tee off at 8:30 am). Driving range will be open at 7:30 am.
- Afternoon scramble golfers arrive by 12:45 pm (lunch at 1:00 pm). Driving range will be open at 12:00 noon.
- Two ways to qualify to play in the scramble:
 - Give a minimum donation of \$250.00 for an individual or \$900.00 for a foursome who sign-up together, or...
 - Give a smaller donation yourself, plus send out 15 individual letters to friends asking them to also give a tax-deductible donation to The Navigators along with you (a printable letter is on our website).
- Several fun contests with prizes – longest drive, closest to the pin, etc.
- Lunch buffet at 1:00 pm with **Frank Tanana of the Detroit Tigers** sharing highlights from his life story while we eat.
